Anna's Story

Anna Rebecca VanSickle was born on August 14, 2002 to parents Nate and Karin. When Anna was two months old, she was diagnosed with Familial Hemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis (FHLH) a very rare, life-threatening, immune-deficiency disease. In early 2003, Anna received chemotherapy and a bone marrow transplant in an attempt to save her life. Sadly, Anna lost her fight on March 4, 2003 at the age of 6-1/2 months.



As Anna's family, it is our hope that through Anna we can raise money for further research on FHLH. Twenty years ago, children who were diagnosed with this disease died within months with no known treatment for the disease. Today, there is a protocol that includes chemotherapy, steroids, and a bone marrow transplant, which has proven successful, bringing the survival rate up considerably. FHLH is still devastating, but with more research doctors will have more treatment plans, parents have more options, and the children have a better chance.
